Options for food sales from concession stands

- No permit needed if sale of food is limited to:
 - Packaged shelf stable bagged snacks
 - Packaged shelf stable candy
 - Water in unopened bottles
 - Shelf stable bottled or canned drinks.



Options for food sales from concession stands

- **Temporary food establishment permit**
 - Applicable to events happening after regular school hours, such as carnivals, dances or athletic events
 - Permit can be obtained by food vendor or school
 - Needed for each instance of food sales, valid for up to fourteen days per event
 - Cost ranges from \$131-\$198 per booth for one to fourteen days



Options for food sales from concession stands

- **Annual permit for Concession Stands**
 - Facility must meet minimum construction requirements
 - Equipment must meet sanitation requirements
 - Permit valid for a fiscal year and is renewable.
 - Cost ranges from \$94-\$189 per year depending on permit type



Options for food sales from concession stands

- **Seasonal permit**
 - Permit good for 4 – 8 months at specified location
 - Only issued once per calendar year
 - Food vendor must use NSF equipment
 - Food vendor must operate out of a permitted commissary
 - Cost \$100-300 per booth depending upon length of time



Options for food sales from concession stands

- **Annual Itinerant permit**
 - One permit for one event at a time
 - Applicable to events happening after regular school hours, such as carnivals, dances or athletic events
 - Permit can be obtained by food vendor or school
 - Permit valid for one fiscal year and is renewable
 - Requires a commissary
 - Cost \$521 or \$782 per booth for fiscal year depending upon type of food



Options for food sales from concession stands

- Contract with a permitted mobile vendor or one of the other previous permit examples
- No other permit is needed if only one vendor is operating at the event



Options for food sales from concession stands

- If there are two or more mobile vendors, annual itinerant or temporary food establishments at any single event, then school needs to apply for an event coordinator permit.
