
This guide identifies the shifts in grade book procedures when a school moves from traditional grade reporting to standards-based reporting (SBRC). For complete guidance on setting up the SBRC grade book, visit <u>training.ccsd.net</u> and select Grade Book.

#### Adding an Assignment

In standards-based reporting, assignments are based on scoring rubrics. Select the appropriate category, standard cluster(s), and then select Rubric under the scoring type.

# Posting Progress Grades

In standards-based reporting, teachers must actively determine grades by analyzing score trends for each student in each standard/cluster. Grades will not auto populate by using the orange **Post** link in the grade book.

## Posting Grades for Report Cards

Grades will <u>not</u> auto populate. Determine grades by analyzing trends. Posting grades for report cards will be done at set times throughout the year. You will be given the dates when all grades must be finalized and posted. Report cards can be printed by the administration or by the classroom teacher.

	<ol> <li>When the Task is set to enter the grade for a required Strand/Domain, <i>In Progress</i> data is displayed. The <i>Grade</i> (Trend) and the <i>Evidence</i> (Sparkline Proficiency Graphs) can be used to make grading judgements.</li> </ol>				
	2. When the Task is set for entering the Semester 1 or 2 grade, by selecting from the $\sqrt{Post By}$ drop-down menu All				
	Standards and Grading Tasks or Student, the In Progress data will display so that the Trend and Sparkline				
	Proficiency Graphs for the subject's Standards can be used to make grading judgements.
